

Day 1-Today we head to Moline Illinois, our home for the next two nights. Experience the feel of Las Vegas in the center of the heartland at Jumer's Casino & Hotel. They offer 205 beautifully appointed rooms. The hotel also boasts an indoor heated pool and a fitness center. After checking in and relaxing a bit, we are headed to the Circa 21 Dinner Playhouse. Circa 21 thrives in Rock Island's historic Fort Armstrong Theatre. Built in 1921 as a vaudeville and silent movie house, it was among the most popular and unique of its day. After extensive remodeling, Circa 21 opened in June of 1977 as the Quad Cities only professional dinner theatre. Tonights production of "**Hairspray**" is sure to please.

Day 2-After a hot breakfast at the hotel we are going to tour the Rock Island Arsenal. Rock Island Arsenal is an active US Army facility located on a 946-acre island in the Mississippi River. In 1969, the arsenal was placed on the National Register of Historic Places. In 1989, the original arsenal buildings were designated a National Historic Landmark. Rock Island Arsenal is our nation's largest government owned and operated arsenal. The importance of the island was identified as early as 1809, when it was set aside as a federal military reservation by an Act of Congress. After our tour here, it's time to board the Celebration Belle, the largest luxury excursion vessel on the upper Mississippi River! Our 4 hour cruise includes homemade sticky rolls, full hot lunch buffet, afternoon shrimp fest, and of course, live entertainment playing your favorite Classic Oldies music. After we depart the Belle, we are going to tour the Deere-Wiman House. The Deere-Wiman House in the late 1800s was originally Victorian in architecture. After a fire in 1899 caused extensive damage to the home, its exterior was redone in stucco, as it appears today. In 1872, John Deere's son, Charles, built the Deere-Wiman House for his wife, Mary Little Dickinson Deere, and their daughters, Anna and Katherine, born in 1864 and 1866, respectively. They named their Swiss Villa style residence "Overlook" because of its desirable hilltop location above the growing city of Moline, Illinois, and the family business, the John Deere Plow Works. Overlook served as home to four generations of Deere descendants.

Day 3- After another hot breakfast buffet at the hotel we are going to tour the Isabel Bloom Studio. More than 50 years ago, midwestern artist Isabel Bloom began sharing her passion for handcrafted sculpture designed to resemble the weathered bronze look of the Victorian era. Today, her protege, Donna Young, continues to honor Isabel's style while creating exciting new sculpture designs.
