

Day 1-Our journey begins today as we head to Bedford, Pennsylvania the Hampton Inn for the evening. Dinner tonight is included and will be at Ed's Steak House.

Day 2-After breakfast today we are headed to Williamsburg, Virginia and the Hampton Inn located in the Historic District. After a little R & R we will have an included dinner at the Whaling Company this evening. We may even have a visit from a very special person this evening!

Day 3-After another breakfast at the hotel, we will visit the Prime Outlets at Williamsburg. Ranked within the top 10 outlet centers in the U.S., Prime Outlets Williamsburg offers the largest outlet shopping selection in Southeastern Virginia with more than 120 designer and brand name outlet stores. This afternoon finds us in Colonial Williamsburg. Step into the past, join in the creation of a new nation, and be swept up in the daily life of a busy 18th century city. Greet shopkeepers, slaves and outspoken patriots. Visit original and restored homes, public buildings and shops. Stroll more than 90 acres of landscaped gardens and courtyards. Tonight's included dinner is an authentic 18th century meal in Shields Tavern, one of 4 historic dining taverns located within Colonial Williamsburg.

Day 4-After this morning's breakfast it's off to Yorktown. A museum of the American revolution, the Yorktown Victory Center chronicles America's struggle for independence, from the beginnings of colonial unrest to the formation of the new nation. It also provides insight into the events that led to conflict between the American colonies and Britain, the war's impact on ordinary men and women, and the creation of the Constitution and the Bill of Rights. This afternoon will find us in Jamestown. A museum of 17th century Virginia, Jamestown Settlement tells the story of America's first permanent English colony. Exhibit areas feature an indoor theater, exhibition galleries and outdoor living history in re-created settings. In outdoor re-creations of a Powhatan Indian village, three ships-Susan Constant, Godspeed, and Discovery-that brought 104 men and boys to Jamestown and colonial fort, historical interpreters depict daily life of 17th century Virginia. Dinner is included this evening and will be at a local restaurant.

Day 5-Today's breakfast will be followed by a day in Norfolk. We start our day at the Norfolk Botanical Gardens. This premier horticultural attraction represents an oasis of more than 30 distinctly themed gardens encompassing 155 breath taking acres. Bordered on three sides by beautiful Lake Whitehurst, we will have a 20 minute narrated tram tour highlighting the different gardens. The Gardens brilliantly feature some of the East Coast's largest collections of azaleas, camellias, roses and rhododendrons. We follow this up with a tour of the Naval Station Norfolk. This step on guided tour will take us through the world's largest naval installation where we will see aircraft carriers, destroyers and submarines as well as the house from the 1917 Jamestown Expedition on Admirals Row. After some free time at Harborfest, we will board the Spirit of Norfolk for a cruise that gives us a front row seat for the Tall Ships "Parade of Ships" Dinner this evening is at the Freemason Abbey in downtown Norfolk and is included.

Day 6-After breakfast we will tour one of the most famous homes in the country, Monticello. Monticello is the autobiographical masterpiece of Thomas Jefferson, designed and redesigned and built and rebuilt for more than forty years. The Monticello plantation of 5,000 acres was a center of agriculture and industry, and was home not only to the Jefferson family, but to workers, black and white, enslaved and free. And as you know, it is pictured on the back of our nickel. We will overnight in Somerset, Pennsylvania this evening with an included dinner.

Day 7-Our last breakfast together before heading home with great memories from another Excellent Adventure.
